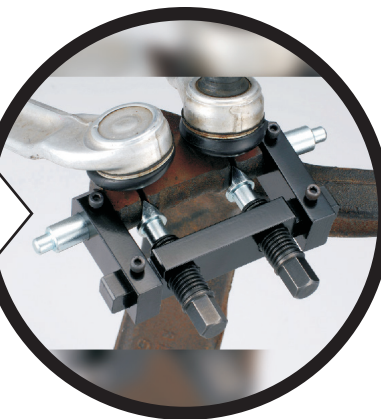
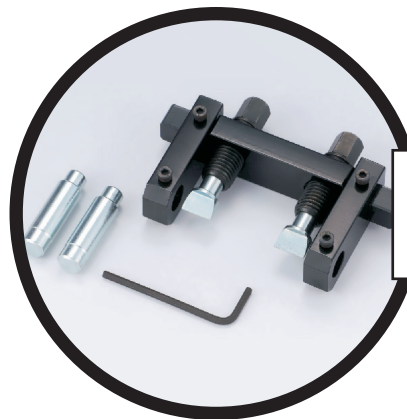
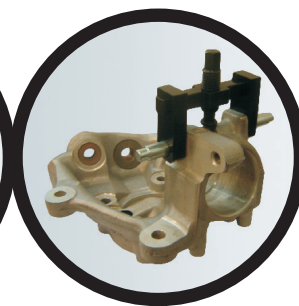
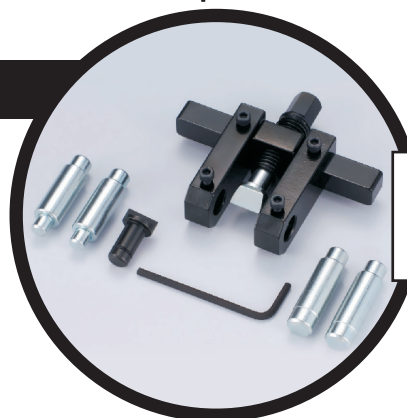


## Universal Steering Knuckle Spreader

- Designed for twin ball joints as fitted to Audi and VW control arms.

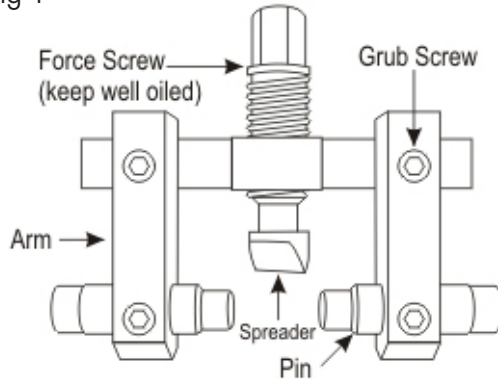


## Instructions

Designed for hubs with clamping style struts (A) and ball joint mounts (B)

1. Remove hub clamp bolt.
2. Select the correct size pins to match bolt holes.
3. Set up the spreader as in fig 1.
4. Slide the pins into the bolt hole.  
Position the tool on the car and secure the arms and pins with grub screws.
5. Expand the hub by using a spanner or socket and wrench screw until the ball joint or strut moves.
